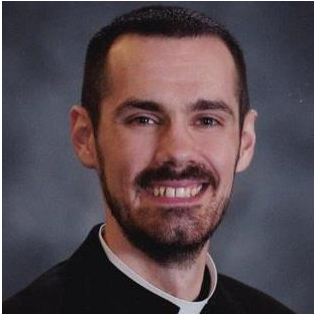

Reflection for Respect Life Month, October 2016, from the Office of Life, Justice and Peace in the Archdiocese of Portland:

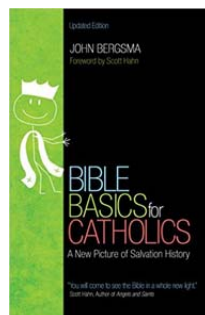
